

Ohio's SACWIS Alleged Perpetrator Search (OSAPS)



What is OSAPS?

The State of Ohio provides a user-friendly platform called the Ohio SACWIS AP Search (OSAPS) that will return results for:


- ➤ Employees of out-of-state, children services agencies seeking Ohio child abuse or neglect information to assist with an active child protective services case, or for use in approving individuals for foster parenting and/or adoptions.
- ➤ Employees or prospective employees seeking to provide child welfare-related employment condition verifications. (Note: This does not apply to current and prospective child care providers.)
- Individuals who want to confirm whether they have been named as an alleged perpetrator in a report of abuse or neglect in Ohio.

You will be taken to the OSAPS login page. Click on the Log in from OHID button.




