Governor

- Approves or vetoes laws
- Appoints members to State Board of Education, Board of Regents, First Things First Board and Arizona State Board for Charter Schools



Legislature

- Sets state budget contributions to education funding
- Sets laws for charters, open enrollment and school savings accounts



County Superintendent

- Appoints district board members when seats go unfilled
- Makes reports to state superintendent



School Board

- Hires superintendent
- Sets curriculum
- Sets staff disciplinary policies
- Manages budget and property



State Superintendent

- Distributes education funding
- Executes education policies
- Serves on State Board of Education and Arizona State Board for Charter Schools

- Set tuition.
